



Vienna – 4 November 2016, The Government of Senegal held a launching ceremony in Dakar on 3 November 2016 to announce the Fifth Forum on Inclusive and Sustainable Industrial Development (ISID), co-organized with the United-Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO).

“Industry will develop Senegal” said Minister of Industry and Mines Aly Ngouille Ndiaye, in reference to the Government’s emphasis on the industrial component of the national development strategy, the Plan Sénégal Émergent, which is implemented with the support of UNIDO’s Programme for Country Partnership (PCP).

The Fifth ISID Forum will strengthen the dialogue between industrial stakeholders from Senegal and regional and international partners. Concurrently, the event will promote the PCP-PSE partnership to other African countries in view of replicating this successful industrial development approach.
