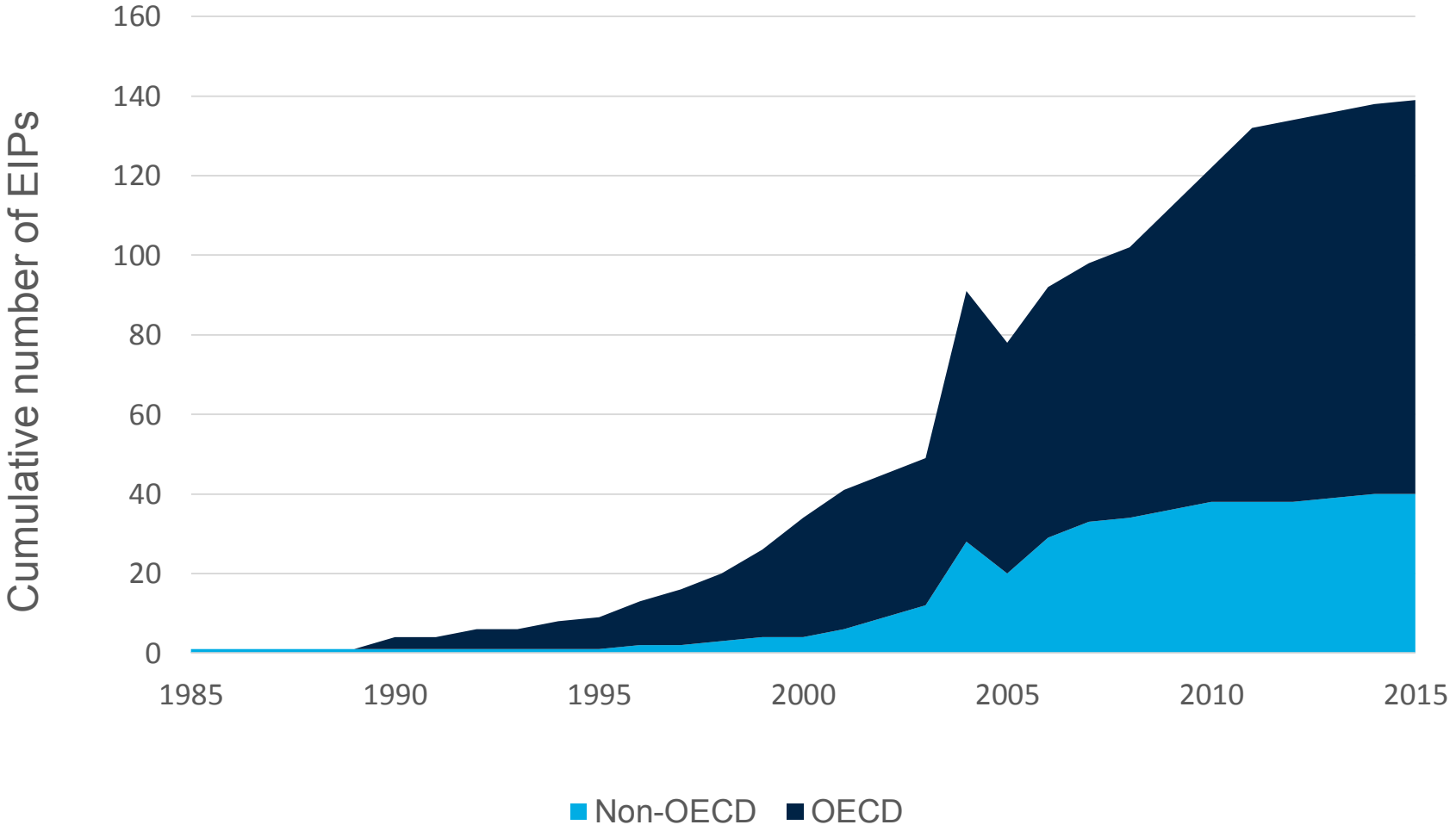

Set of pragmatic indicators

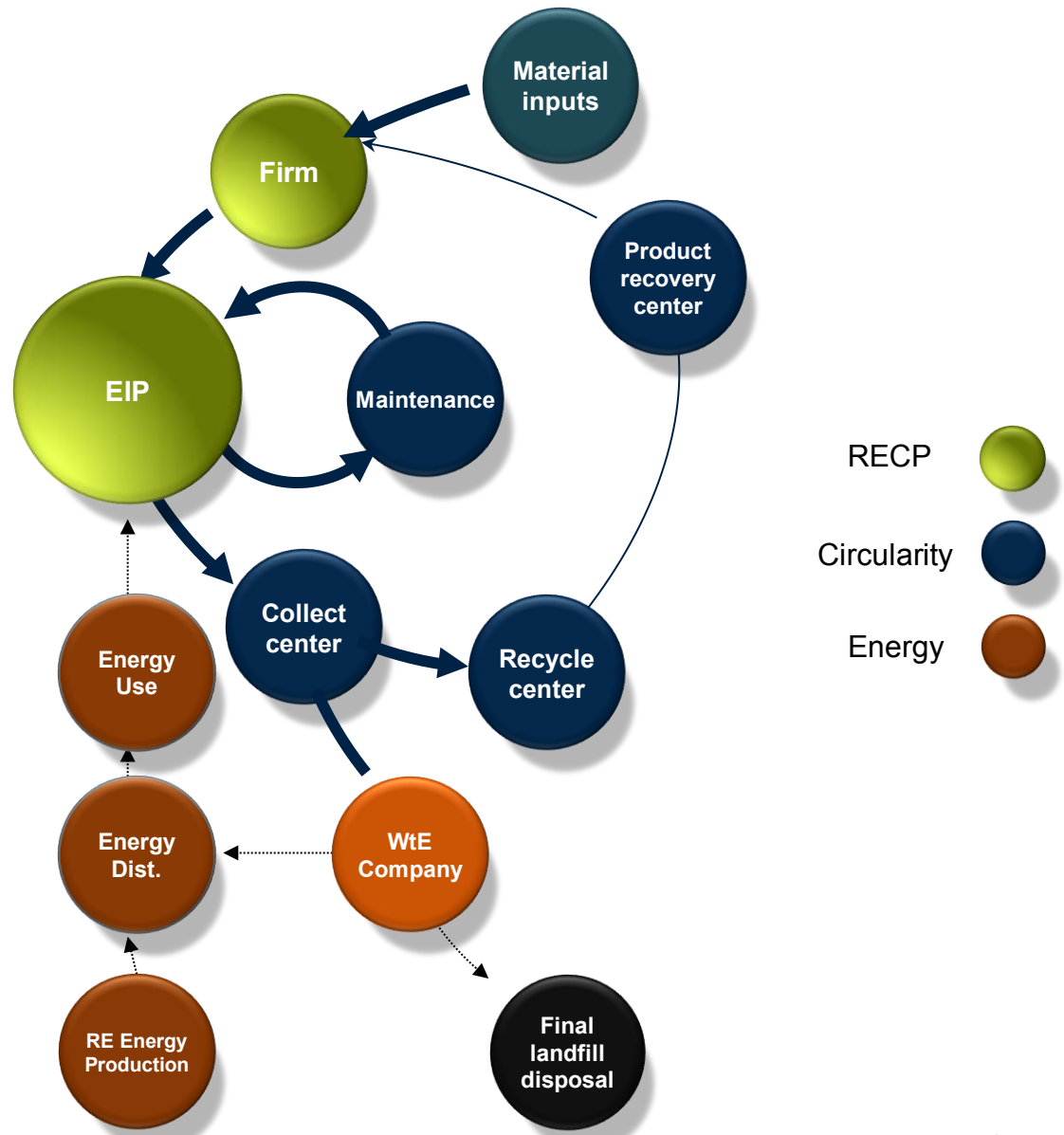
- Clear guidelines
